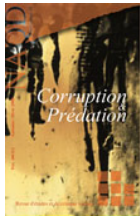

New Eurozine associate: NAQD



NAQD, the Algerian journal of social criticism, is now an associate of Eurozine. *NAQD* is the first and only independent Maghreb journal contributing to the development and circulation of contemporary critical reflection. Published annually in French and Arabic, its articles discuss and focus on key issues affecting the societies of Algeria, Maghreb, and the rest of the Arabic-speaking world.

NAQD was founded in 1991 by a group of Algerian academics and intellectuals as an independent critical project; its main aim is to shed light on current problems by instigating a politically independent, critical, and rationalist discourse. *NAQD* is entirely independent of government and relies on subscriptions from libraries and universities in North Africa, Europe and the US.
